III. Dissertation : Three credits

2. The total credits in both semesters shall be 24 and each semester shall be of 12 credits as indicated below:

First Semester:

(i) 2 Foundation/Compulsory Papers : 2x3= 6 credits (ii) 3 Optional/Specialization Paper* : 3x2=6 credits

Second Semester:

(i) 1 Foundation/Compulsory Paper : 1x3=3 credits (ii) 3 Optional/Specialization Paper* : 3x2= 6 credits (iii) Dissertation : 3 credits

3. The System of Evaluation of Students:

The evaluation of students in a course shall be on two segments:

(i) Continuous Evaluation by the Teachers (40 marks) (ii) Evaluation through Semester Examination (60 marks)

The component and respective weightage to be given to each component of Continuous Evaluation shall be as follows:-

(i) Sessionals : 20 marks

Class Tests (one best out of two)

(ii) Attendance : 05 marks

(Lectures, Tutorials)

Marks will be awarded proportionate to the attendance

(iii) Written assignment & Presentation : 15 marks

Total : 40 marks

4. The Dissertation and its viva- voce examination shall be evaluated / conducted by an External Examiner appointed by the Director of the Center out of panel, approved by the Academic Council on the recommendation of the Board of Studies in Law.

5. Syllabi:

Note:

(i) Any two groups of Specialization opted by the majority of the students shall only be offered finally.

(ii) Minimum of six papers shall be offered in each of the group of specialization mentioned above. Out of these papers, students are required to choose any three in the first Semester and three in the Second Semester (in the respective group of specialization). Finally, 3 papers opted by the majority of the students (in respective group of Specialization) in the first semester and 3 papers opted by the majority of students in the second semester shall be offered.
