Greetings from NQOCN, India.

As you are aware the Infant Mortality Rate (41 per 1000 live births) in Uttar Pradesh is very high. Uttar Pradesh has a Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) of 201 per one lakh live births. While there has been a significant improvement in under five mortality and infant mortality rates in the recent years, the reduction in neonatal mortality rate has been very slow (30 per 1000 live birth). Government of Uttar Pradesh is implementing various activities/programmatic interventions to address this important issue, and these include quality care provision during intra-partum and immediate postpartum, Facility based newborn care, Home based newborn care and Immunization. UNICEF office support Govt. of Uttar Pradesh in providing supportive supervision for strengthening of LaQshya (24 districts), FBNC and HBNC Programmes in all 75 districts for addressing high neonatal and maternal mortality.

In this context, UNICEF organized a 2 days' workshop on Quality Improvement for Maternal and Neonatal Healthcare Delivery System for Quality Consultants, LR staff and SNCU staff of UP in two batches, 29-30 January and 3-4 May 2019 with the technical support of NQOCN, India. As a further step in the same direction, it is planned to optimally utilize the knowledge gained and implement QI activities in the facilities, NQOCN will conduct mentoring visits to the selected facilities along with the UNICEF and NHM Quality Consultants of NHM from neighbouring districts.

NQOCN team will conduct the onsite mentoring visits to the district hospitals of Shrawasti, Balrampur and Sonbhadra in teams consisting of 3 coaches for each district (one nurse mentor, one QI doctor coach and one QI Obstetric Coach). The team will be accompanied by UNICEF and NHM Quality Consultants of NHM from neighboring districts. The onboard team will be conducting onsite mentoring for the aforementioned districts at a frequency of 4-6 weeks (total of 3 visits till Dec 2019). The teams will initially undertake to capacity build the DH teams in QI and undertake one demonstration LaQshya QI project which will be conducted over 8-10 weeks and sustained for 4 weeks during the course of this project. This will serve to build the capacity of teams in conducting the 6 QICs as envisaged in the LaQshya program.

The main activities in each onsite visit will consist of:

- Records reviewing as per the need of the project
- Solving problems through QI tools (POCQI)
- On spot skill building of staff (Mentoring/Coaching)
- Data analysis (using easy to learn QI tools like time series charts, fishbone etc)
- Report writing (at the conclusion of the first project)
- Measuring improvements using process and/or outcome indicators as defined by the participating teams.

INTRODUCTION

Yield management can be defined as a process through which the hotel room sales and revenue is increased, it includes various techniques of revenue management. Yield management, or revenue management, is the process by which sales of a limited quantity of goods, such as hotel rooms, airline seats, apartment leasing, rental cars, or etc. are managed in order to maximize profits. Successful yield management focuses on selling the product in such a manner that is timely, price competitive, and directed towards the right subset of customers

It is a set of techniques and procedures used to manipulate occupancy ratio in order to maximize the hotel's revenue. It is also an evaluative tool that allows the Room Divisions Manager to use potential revenue as the standard against which actual revenue can be compared. It works as a tool for revenue and front office on how to increase the revenue for given number of rooms for a given period ofitime

Many hotels rate their success by their occupancy levels, but this isn't necessarily the best measure of success. Another way to rate a hotel's performance is by determining its REVPAR, or Revenue per Available Room. REVPAR is calculated by dividing the total room revenue by the total number of rooms. For example, a hotel that makes Rs. 60,000 one night with a total number of 100 rooms has a REVPAR of Rs. 600.

The revenue manager's job is to maximize the revenue per available room by selling rooms to the right customers, at the right price, at the right time. Successful yield management arises from several factors: an understanding of what the hotel hopes to achieve (whether that is room occupancy, REVPAR, or some other measurement); a clear understanding of what kind of hotel the manager is working with, which will lead to an understanding of what a customer visiting the hotel wants in his or her hotel experience, and why customers choose their hotel over another hotel; an ability to measure group sales against the overall goals of the hotel (for example, a hotel whose main goal is occupancy will be happy to host a large group at a lowered rate, but a hotel whose main goal is revenue may turn down a larger group in favour of a smaller group who can pay a higher rate); and a knowledge of what will cause the market to fluctuate (such as holidays, regular regional and local events, etc.). The yield manager will ideally consider all these factors when creating different rates for hotel guests.

Understanding Revenue Management in detail

As per definition of Wikipedia: revenue management is the process of understanding, anticipating and influencing consumer behaviour in order to maximize revenue or profits from a fixed, perishable resource (such as airline seats or hotel room reservations). This contains both the overarching goal of the process, and its crucial relationship to consumer behaviour. What is revenue management except a means to mould consumer behaviour in a way that benefits the hotel?

The first step in this process is to know consumer behavior which can be beneficial for the hotel. To see the potential guests booking their rooms in the hotel as compared to other hotels at a better price.

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

Though this can be speculation, the relationship between pricing and booking pace (and that of a hotel's competitors) is easily measured, and elucidates the same set of behaviors. Selling a room to a guest at the right price to both maximize occupancy and the revenue it generates is impossible without first considering what will prompt a consumer to make the purchase. It is very easy to understand the consumers buying habits if you are able to collect a property's purchasing data analyze it and then read and interrupt the data in real time. This is easier said than done, but very possible if you have the right system in place.

Anticipating once an understanding of consumer behavior is gleaned- both in a general sense and specific to the property and the property's competitors, then management can begin to anticipate that consumer behavior. This is where the real challenge or revenue management emerges; being as accurate with this anticipation as possible, through forecasting, modeling, and exhaustive research. Only when consumer behavior is at least partially anticipated can a hotel hope to sell and distribute their room inventory effectively; which is how revenue management leads to higher revenues and profitability. Once all data is collected and analyzed a pattern begins to form. This pattern will constantly change and evolve just like any market. The key is to have a system in place with Artificial Intelligence (AI) that can understand and adapt to these changes in real time.

Measuring Yield:



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Another critical part of revenue management is to influence consumer behavior when a hotel can anticipate a consumers decision, then the next logical step is to know that decision in a direction that is helpful for hotel. In terms of selling rooms, exerting influence is largely a function of presentation and sales channel distribution, in an effort to display a room to a customer at the price most likely to incite them to buy (while simultaneously being the price that earns the most revenue for the hotel in that situation). The process of influencing consumer behavior is the capstone of revenue management; it is supported by understanding and anticipating consumer behavior, but in the end it is all the only visible result of a revenue management strategy. Once you have collected and analyzed all of the data; it will be simple to implement the findings into your revenue management processes. By doing so, it will provide you with a huge competitive advantage in the market, thus helping you capture a bigger share of the market.

While executing the technical part of revenue management is important for success of any revenue management strategy, the modification of prices as per the demand and competition is the need of hour and to effectively manage inventory, and sales channel distribution. So remember: Understand, anticipate and influence. These are the fundamentals of revenue management and the keys to a hotel's Measuring Yield financial success.

The Yield Statistic is the Ratio of the Actual Revenue (Generated by the Number of Rooms Sold) to Potential Revenue (THE Amount of Money that would be received from the Sales of Rooms in the Hotel at a Rack Rate)

Formula 1: Potential Average Single Rate:

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Potential Average Single Rate = (Single Room Revenues at Rack Rate) / (Number of Rooms Sold as Single)

Formula 2: Potential Average Double Rate:

Potential Average Double Rate = (Double Room Revenue at Rack Rate) / (Number of Rooms Sold as Double)

Multiple Occupancy Percentage = (Number of Rooms Occupied by more than 1 Person) / (Total Number of Rooms Sold)



ELEMENTS OF YIELD MANAGEMENT

ELEMENTS OF YIELD MANAGEMENT

While developing a successful Yield Strategy, the following Elements are very important:

Group Room Sales

Transient (FIT) Room Sales

Group Room Sales:

Group Booking Data: Determines whether the Group blocks already recorded in the Reservation File should be modified or not and adjusts expectations by reviewing the Group's Booking History


Group booking Pace: Watches out for the Rate at which Group Business is being booked (Consider Historical Trends)

Anticipated Group Business: Watches out for repetitive Group Patterns and act accordingly in order to forecast the Pressure on the Market, and hence adjust Selling Strategies

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Group Booking Lead-Time: Measures how far in advance of a stay Bookings are made. This is very important in determining whether to accept an Additional Group and at what Room Rate to book the New Group

Displacement or Transient Business: Occurs when a Hotel accepts Group Business at the Expense of Transient Guest. This might engender Profitability Problems and Bad Reputation

2. Transient Room Sales:

The Front Office Management shall monitor the Booking Pace and Lead-Time of Transient Guests in order to understand how Current Reservations compare with Historical and Anticipated Rates

USING YIELD MANAGEMENT:

1. Potential High Demand Techniques:

Output to define the Market Segments in order to sell out the Highest Possible Room Rates

- Try to define the Market Segments in order to sell out the Highest Possible Room Rates
- Monitor New Business Bookings and New Corporates coming up.
- Consider establishing a Minimum Number of Nights per Stay
- Select the Group that offers the Highest Total Revenue

2. Potential Low Demand Techniques:

- o Design a flexible rate system for sales force.
- Strive to accurately project expected Market Mix
- o Management shall closely monitor Group Bookings and Trends in Transient Business

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In order to implement these Tactics, Management needs to establish the Hurdle Rate (The Lowest Rate for a Given Day) below which it is impossible to sell any Room

RM Software


The processing of large databases is impossible without appropriate RM software and hotels that employ it gain strategic advantage over those that rely on intuitive RM decisions only. RM software helps RM managers by giving suggestions on price amendments, inventory control and channel management, but it also influences the decision making process of revenue managers. On the one hand, the software analyses enormous data bases and provides useful forecasts based on the optimization models embedded in it. On the other hand, as Schwartz and Cohen (2004) demonstrate, the interface of the software impacts the judgment of revenue managers and their inclination to adjust the computer's' forecasts. However, the ultimate decision lies in the hands of the RM manager and his/her team. Review of related literature shows that RM software and human interactions with it have not received post Grad enough attention by scholars.


Revenue Management Team

Human resource issues are essential in RM system planning and implementation. Authors agree that revenue managers and the revenue management team are vital for the success of any RM system focuses on the specific knowledge and training RM specialists need in order to be effective and efficient. In any case, the introduction and the implementation of RM system within a hotel is a challenging and significant change that might cause resistance among employees and the latter should be addressed and dealt with properly. In many companies the application of RM techniques is within the responsibilities of the marketing manager or a person subordinate to him. However, large hotel chains have recognized the importance of RM to their bottom line and have appointed a separate revenue manager) or even regional revenue management teams to head and guide company's efforts in optimal management of its revenues.

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Ethical issues in hotel Revenue Management

Despite revenue management's perceived positive impacts on hotels' bottom line, Revenue Management techniques have received a huge amount of criticism from various hotel properties in terms of grievances and lack of sensible benefits. This is especially valid for price discrimination and overbooking techniques. Customers feel cheated if they find that they have paid higher price for the same room or if they have to be moved to another hotel. This happens to be a result of lack of or incomplete information about booking, cancellation and amendment terms. In general, research in the area focuses on the perceived fairness of RM from the view point of the customer pinpoints the RM practices that customers consider acceptable or unacceptable. When information about booking, cancellation and amendment terms is available and understood by the customers or when different prices are charged for products perceived by them as different, customers are more inclined to accept revenue management practices. In the other cases, when discounts are insignificant compared to booking amendment/cancellation restrictions or the latter are changed after the booking has been confirmed customers will be dissatisfied. Choi and Mattila (2005) furthermore specify that only

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informing the customers about hotel's rates is not enough to improve their perceived fairness of - they have to know the basis for rates variability (day of the week, duration of stay) and booking conditions.

Legal issues in hotel RM

The legal aspects of hotel Revenue Management are a marginal topic in the academic literature, which is yet to expand. The main focus is the discussion of hotel's RM system as a source of competitive advantage, know-how and its subsequent treatment as a trade secret. Kimes and Wagner emphasise that only parts of RM systems are ascertainable through public sources (e.g. overbookings and forecasting mathematical models), but how RM systems' components are integrated is considered proprietary knowledge and is kept confidential. However, authors call for greater vigilance among hotel managers because high turnover among hospitality employees might cause RM trade secrets leakages to their new employers.

Forecast means to say what will probably happen in future, hence it is the prediction of future happenings based on analysis of data available.

Forecasting Rooms Revenue Example

Information Required for Room Forecasting

The Front Office Manager through their knowledge and experience defined following as necessary for accurate forecasting:

- 1. Thorough Knowledge of Rooms and Rates.
- A perfect judgement of what can happen in future.
- Profile of target market hotel can cover.

Records Required for Room Forecasting Availability:

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The forecasting of room availability requires a lot of efforts from reservation managers in hotels. It requires the information about the past trends also

- The number of check in on each day and during same period.
- Walk In Guests.
- No of under stays.
- No of Over Stays.
- No of Departures.
- No Shows.
- Cancellations.

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Percentage of Walk In

The percentage of Walk in guests is calculated by dividing total number of walk in guests with total number of arrivals and multiplying by 100. Higher the percentage of walk in guests it makes difficult for the hotel to forecast the room availability to All Post

Percentage of No Shows

If a guest with confirmed reservation doesn't turns up in the hotel on the date of arrival that is called as no show. The percentage of no show helps the front office manager to early release of guest rooms. It is calculated by dividing total number of no shows on a specific day by total number of bookings made on the same day and multiplying it by 100.

Percentage of over stay

The guests who stay more and extend their date of departure are called as overstay guests. It results in making the room availability low for that period. This kind of condition hotels expect in the lean season or hotels running on low occupancy can favor the guest by extending their may also.

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Forecasting helps in making strategies for revenue management for the hotels and now a day's hotels are focusing a lot on the revenue management and also customer satisfaction.

Yield Management Prospects in Future

Revenue Management: Chain hotels will move to one to one revenue management systems and each market will be a market segment in itself. Technology will also play an important role in measuring customer value based on historical and present trends.

Customer Value Systems: The main focus will be on Revenue per available guest and calculating customer value which will in turn help hotels in retaining the guests. Hotels will focus to use their function and banquet spaces is also as a part of Yield and Forecasting. The goals and aims of entire staff will be aligned in order to achieve maximum profit and a systematic revenue management system to be implemented. Try to define the Right Mix of Market Segments in order to sell out the Highest Possible Room Rates. Monitor New Business Bookings and use these changed Conditions to reassign Room Inventory. (As Occupancy increases, consider closing out Low Room Rates and open them only when Demand decreases). Consider establishing a Minimum Number of Nights per Stay

Summary:

The yield management is even termed as revenue management or output management. Any hotel organisation looking for profits will have to develop and adopt various yield management strategies in its different operations and front office is not an exception. Hotels can use strategy like forecasting and employee experience to reap benefits from uncertain and competitive market.

Greetings from NQOCN, India .

As you are aware the Infant Mortality Rate (41 per 1000 live births) in Uttar Pradesh is very high. Uttar Pradesh has a Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) of 201 per one lakh live births. While there has been a significant improvement in under five mortality and infant mortality rates in the recent years, the reduction in neonatal mortality rate has been very slow (30 per 1000 live birth). Government of Uttar Pradesh is implementing various activities/programmatic interventions to address this important issue, and these include quality care provision during intra-partum and immediate postpartum, Facility based newborn care, Home based newborn care and Immunization. UNICEF office support Govt. of Uttar Pradesh in providing supportive supervision for strengthening of LaQshya (24 districts), FBNC and HBNC Programmes in all 75 districts for addressing high neonatal and maternal mortality.

In this context, UNICEF organized a 2 days' workshop on Quality Improvement for Maternal and Neonatal Healthcare Delivery System for Quality Consultants, LR staff and SNCU staff of UP in two batches, 29-30 January and 3-4 May 2019 with the technical support of NQOCN, India. As a further step in the same direction, it is planned to optimally utilize the knowledge gained and implement QI activities in the facilities, NQOCN will conduct mentoring visits to the selected facilities along with the UNICEF and NHM Quality Consultants of NHM from neighbouring districts.

NQOCN team will conduct the onsite mentoring visits to the district hospitals of Shrawasti, Balrampur and Sonbhadra in teams consisting of 3 coaches for each district (one nurse mentor, one QI doctor coach and one QI Obstetric Coach). The team will be accompanied by UNICEF and NHM Quality Consultants of NHM from neighboring districts. The onboard team will be conducting onsite mentoring for the aforementioned districts at a frequency of 4-6 weeks (total of 3 visits till Dec 2019). The teams will initially undertake to capacity build the DH teams in QI and undertake one demonstration LaQshya QI project which will be conducted over 8-10 weeks and sustained for 4 weeks during the course of this project. This will serve to build the capacity of teams in conducting the 6 QICs as envisaged in the LaQshya program.

The main activities in each onsite visit will consist of:

- Records reviewing as per the need of the project
- Solving problems through QI tools (POCQI)
- On spot skill building of staff (Mentoring/Coaching)
- Data analysis (using easy to learn QI tools like time series charts, fishbone etc)
- Report writing (at the conclusion of the first project)

 Measuring improvements using process and/or outcome indicators participating teams.
