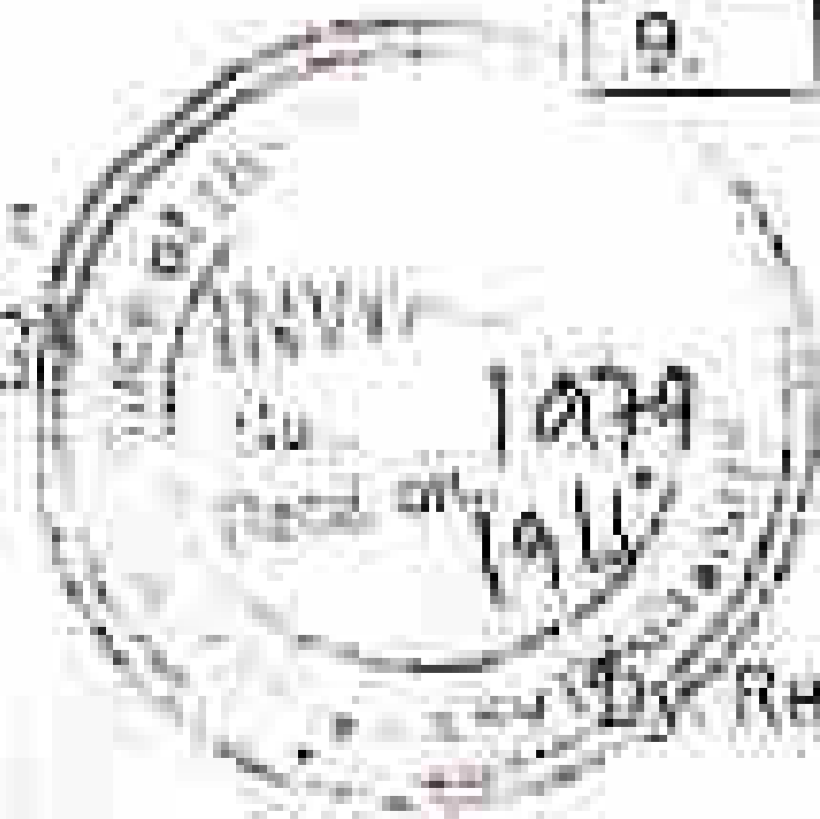

Subject: - Complaint against Question Paper of CE-03-01 Structure Analysis-I (From the Session 2017-18), B. Tech 3rd Semester Examination held on 17.11.2017.

Placed opposite at flag "PUC" is a complaint against Question Paper cited as subject. The Subject Experts of CE-02-01, B. Tech 3rd Semester complaint that Paper supplied overall difficult level of the Paper was very high and was beyond the level of a Junior class of B. Tech 3rd Semester. The Paper was too lengthy to be solved in the given time of 3 hours by the students of B. Tech 3rd Semester. They requested to give sympathetic consideration for final assessment of the subject.

The complaint is received through proper channel on 22.12.2017 in this office.

In this connection, it is submitted that the MMU, Calender Volume I, 2009, Rule 16.1 at page 107, which is reproduced below:-

"Complaints against question papers shall be entertained only if they are made by and/or through the Head of a recognized College/Chairperson, University Department and received by the Controller of Examinations by name under Registered cover or in person, within seven days of the examination in that paper. No complaint will be entertained thereafter."

In terms of the above mentioned provisions, the complaint is not received within time and time -barred. Hence not covered under the rule.

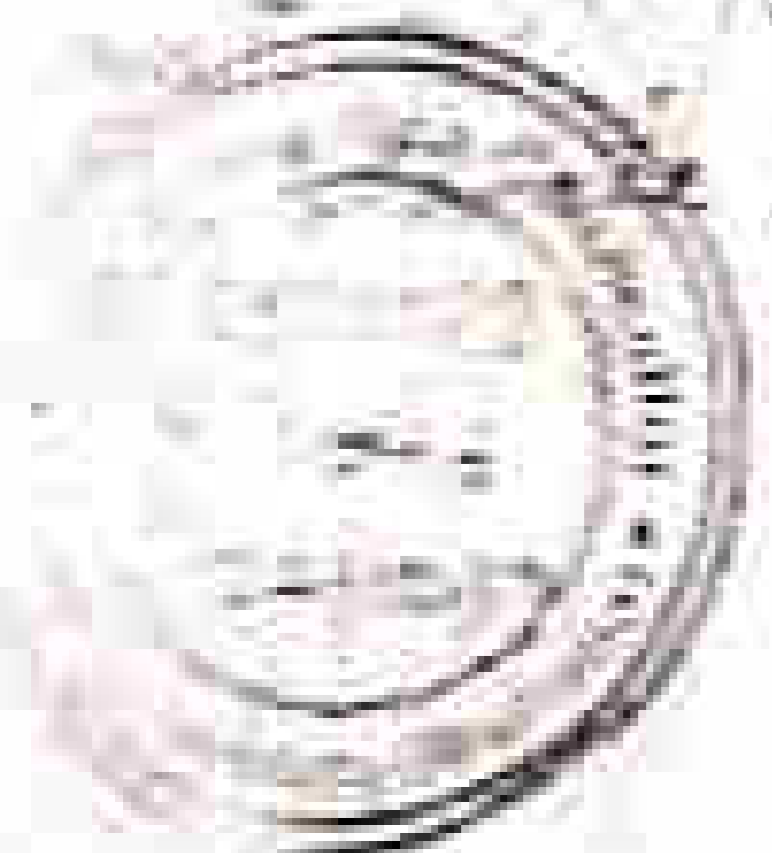


