**Memorandum of Understanding  
National Tuberculosis Eradication Programme  
Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for the participation of  
Private Providers/PPP Partner.**

This MOU is executed on between the State Health Society (Haryana) having its office at office of Director General Health Services, Sector 6, Panchkula, acting through its Deputy Director Health Services – State TB Officer (Hereinafter called "the Grantor, which expression shall unless exclude by or repugnant to the context include its successors in-interest, executors, administrators and legal representatives) And Maharishi Markandeshwar Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Mullana hence forth referred to as PPP Partner, having its office at Mullana University Road, Mullana, Ambala, Haryana acting through its.....(Hereinafter called "the Grantee", which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context include its successors it, interest, executors, administrators and legal representatives).

WHEREAS the Grantor plans to implement "National TB Eradication Programme the partnership **Option 5 Treatment Services : Centre 3 DR TB Treatment Centre Indoor as per Guidance Document on Partnerships CTD 2019** through the Grantee AND WHEREAS the Grantor has agreed to engage the services of the Grantee, subject to terms and as hereunder.

1. The activities would be implemented in MMIMSR, Mullana for all districts of Haryana

2. Period of Co-operation: The PPP Partner agrees to perform all activities outlined in the guideline for partnerships in above mentioned area. The duration of cooperation will be from 24<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023(or the day of the starting the activity / function whichever is later.

Contract will normally be signed for a period of three year, renewable every year as per the needs of the programme, subject to satisfactory performance. The contract can be terminated by the District Health Society/ State Health Society or the PPP Partner any time with one month prior notice. The contract will automatically end on the last day of the contract if not renewed.

3. Terms, conditions and specific services during the period of the MOU.

#### A. **Service Provider** to ensure

- It is a registered entity essentially a Health facility.
- It will comply to the National Guidelines for Air-Borne Infection Control for Out and In-Patient Settings.
- It will institute a DR-TB Committee in the facility as per the national DR-TB guidelines.
- It will have relevant specialties like pulmonologist, physician, paediatrician, psychiatrist, dermatologist, cardiologist, ENT, ophthalmologist, gastroenterologist & gynaecologist etc. to whom patients can be linked for second opinions.
- It will have in-house laboratory services (or adequate linkages) required for pre-treatment and follow-up investigations to ensure that patient does not have to be referred elsewhere.
- It will have dedicated DR-TB indoor management facility.

#### A. **Role of Service Provider**

1. The medical college shall provide **all facilities free of cost** to all DR TB patients and ensure their privacy and confidentiality.
2. Follow RNTCP Diagnostics and Treatment Protocol for managements of DRTB Patients .
3. Establish Rapid Diagnostics Molecular facility or linkages need to be established with the help of programme for DR TB Diagnostics.
4. Provide collection and transport facility for all types of DR TB specimens sputum as well as non-sputum specimen extrapulmonary including FNAC, biopsy, bronchioalveolar lavage, bronchial lavage etc
5. Constitute DR TB Committee which should minimally include service of clinicians (Chest and TB, Medicine, Paediatrics, surgery and psychiatry), Microbiologist, Hospital infection focal control point.
6. Ensure all clinicians and supportive staff undergo formal training of PMDT (at least 3 days training)
7. Make available (or establish linkages) for pre-treatment evaluation tests required for all DR TB regimens as per programme guidelines
8. Assign inpatient space (ward) with minimum four beds Male and Female and two paediatrics beds admission. All these beds should be equipped to handle sick patients such as in High Dependency Unit.



9. Establish a single window mechanism in the hospital for all TB related services to ensure patient convenience.
10. Screen and manage Adverse Drug Reaction (ADR) including free provision of ancillary drugs for the DRTB patients. Maintain and update the active Drug Safety Monitoring (aDSM) forms for all Adverse Events (AE) as per programme guidelines.
11. Provide Counselling services to all DR TB patients for infection control, treatment adherence, follow up schedule, possible side effects etc
12. Assign supportive staff to maintain records (registers and treatment cards) and submit reports to State TB Cell/ District TB Center regularly.
13. Conduct regular (atleast on quarterly basis ) meeting of DR Tb committee in coordination with DTO to review decisions on patient regimen, record and reports as well as Nikshay Entry updated timely.
14. Coordinate with JRL [Karnal] for DST/DRT results.
15. Undergo periodic trainings on the PMDT guidelines and updates.
16. Make laboratory investigation available for pre-treatment evaluation and follow up **free of cost**.
17. Provide services for treatment initiation, follow-up care and ADR management **free of cost**.
18. Provide referral facilities for expert opinion of other medical specialties, if required **free of cost**.
19. Coordinate with the [RNTCP] to ensure a steady supply of DR-TB drugs.
20. Provide commodities, services and drugs to the patients **free of cost**, including all ancillary drugs required.
21. Update and maintain records and registers as per PMDT in Nikshay and Nikshay Aushadhi as per latest NTEP guidelines ( updated time to time)
22. Coordinate with RNTCP / designated labs / assigned DR-TB OPD to update patient records and share relevant information related to patients.
23. Perform all activities as agreed upon and signed under the partnership option MoU.
24. Maintain adequate documentation of as NTEP policy which is mentioned under the partnership option.
25. On completion of tasks in the said project the Grantee will furnish to the Grantor a copy of an administrative /yearly report covering the details of project activities and studies undertaken by it. The Grantor shall have a right to call upon the Grantee to

furnish such additional supplementary reports, or other documents, papers or writing as in the opinion of the Grantor are necessary or proper in connection with completion of the project

26. The Grantee shall not delegate, transfer or assign sublet this MOU in whole or in part or otherwise, the obligations under this MOU to any person, firm or company or any other institution/ organization without obtaining the prior written approval of the grantor.
27. Any publication/study arising out of this MOU shall have to have prior permission of grantee.

#### **B. The District/State Health Society shall**

1. Provide material support to the NGO/ PP for carrying out the activities as mentioned in the partnership guideline.
2. Provide relevant copy of technical guidelines, updates, manuals & circulars, etc.
3. Provide RNTCP drugs, logistics and laboratory consumables for use as per RNTCP policy as outlined the partnership guideline \
4. Provide linkages and consumables required for specimen collection and transportation to offer tests as per integrated DR TB algorithm.
5. Provide training to build capacity of service providers on NTEP guidelines on management of DR-TB and Nikshay. Annual refresher training to be organised for update.
6. Stock FDC, Loose drugs( first and second line drugs) including drugs for prophylaxis
7. Identify convenient Treatment Supporter for patient to ensure treatment adherence at field level
8. Provide reporting formats and registers
9. Periodically review the performance and activities being undertaken by the NGO/ PP Partner
10. No additional HR except for RNTCP LT and Medical Officer already in place which may be involved.

**5. Grievance Redressal Mechanism** All grievances will be addressed within a period of thirty days by DTO/STO of the concerned district/ states. Final decision will rest with state/ district Health Societies. Annual review would be a platform for addressing grievance of PPM partners.

**6. Right over Information/data:** All documents, information, statistics and data collected by the Grantee in the discharge of the obligation under the MOU incidental or related to it (whether or not submitted to the Grantor) shall be the joint property of the Grantor, and the Grantee

**7. Indemnity :**The Grantee hereby agrees to always keep the Grantor indemnified and harmless from all claims /demands / action and proceedings which may arise by reason of any activity undertaken by Grantee if the activity is not in accordance with the approved guidelines. This MOU shall be enforceable in courts situated at Ambala,Haryana ; any suit or application for enforcement of the above shall be filed in the competent court at Ambala and no other district of Haryana or outside Haryana shall have any Jurisdiction in the matter

**8. Termination Mechanism :** \_The partnership may be terminated by either side through written notice of one month. If the Grantor at any stage decides that the Grantee has misutilised any part of NTEP guidelines (or any part thereof) has fraudulently claimed any covenants, stipulation or obligations hereunder a commits a breach of any of the terms, conditions or provision of this MOU on its part to be observed and performed, or it at any stage reasonable ground exist to apprehend the breach of the terms and condition of the MOU in future or that the continuance of this project may be prejudiced or be in jeopardy he/she may revoke this MOU wholly or partially and ask the Grantee to refund the amount/logistics till then along with interest accrues, if any after giving at least fifteen days' notice and an opportunity of being heard to the Grantee.
