Conclusion

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

The rally was conducted with great enthusiasm and participants enjoyed the ride. The atmosphere was filled with a sense of camaraderie and sportsmanship.




The purpose of this event was a call to action;

Global leaders: Champion liver health by expanding hepatitis treatment and testing, as fundamental to universal health coverage.


National leaders, especially those in highly affected countries: Take liver health seriously and expand access to hepatitis testing, treatment and cure closer to home.

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


World AIDS Vaccine Day (18th May 2023)



Report Teacher's Day celebration



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



Report Standard Penetration Test

The civil engineering department organized a two-day field workshop for B-Tech 3rd and 4th year students on 06/04/2022 and 07/04/2022. The primary objective of this objective workshop is to establish the geotechnical condition of site and evaluate the allowable bearing pressure and other engineering design parameters of soil sub grade. To obtain the required data Standard Penetration Test (SPT) was performed. SPT is an in-situ dynamic penetration test designed to provide geotechnical engineering properties of soil. The moto of this workshop was to enlighten students about the practicality and technicality of the soil testing done in field. To obtain sub-surface stratification four boreholes were drilled in the construction area by manually auger method. The samples collected were then transported the laboratory where various test like Particle Size Analysis, Bulk Density, Natural Moisture Content and Atterberg's limit were carried out.

Dr. Vanita Aggarwal (Head of the Civil Engineering Department) along with other faculty members Dr. B.S Walia and Er. Vikas Sofat explained students in detail all the technicalities of the test and all the measures which need to be countered while field testing.

In workshop they highlighted the importance of software in the present scenario for civil engineering students and how this software are helpful to enhance their skills to get better jobs.


